

Global Summit: UN Resolution Preparation Guide

This guide should help you use the information presented in a UN Resolution as you prepare for the global summit.

1. Actively read the resolution.
2. What agreements, summits, plans, conferences, conventions, etc. are mentioned in the resolution? Find out about them. Is your country a participant or signatory to them? Can you find any press releases or statements by your country about the agreements, summits, or plans?
3. What are the major issues of the topic of the resolution? (ex: if the topic is the global climate, then one of the major issues is emissions of greenhouse gasses) Can you find any press releases or statements by your country about the major issues?

4. Does the UN have a website devoted to the topic of the resolution? (ex: if the topic is the global climate, you would check out the website for the United Nations Environment Programme) What does the website say about the topic and major issues? Based on what you have found about your country, would it agree or disagree with the calls for action, recommendations, or information?

5. Go to the website for your country's regional organization (ex: if your country is in Europe, go to the EU's website). Can you find any resolutions, press releases, statements, or other information by the organization about the major issues?
